

iPad Contribution Scheme 2020/21

Issue 1, 27th August 2020



For 2020/21, we are pleased to be able to offer new students the option to purchase a discounted iPad via a monthly payment scheme, in conjunction with our supplier (Academia Ltd). All options include a **2 year insurance plan** (covering accidental damage), **3 year extended warranty** and **STM Dux case** to protect your device.

In addition, for Option 1, Portsmouth College will pay the equivalent of £8 per month towards your iPad, reducing your monthly payment to the equivalent of **£10.58** (see note 1) – please see overleaf for more information.

If you qualify for a bursary (see note 2) the College will provide you with an iPad at no cost, for as long as you are a student. This device will remain the property of the College and **you will need to return it when you leave**. You can of course still choose to sign up to the contribution scheme if you would like to own an iPad.

Finally, if you already have an iPad, you are of course welcome to use that in College. However, please note we cannot accept any liability for damage or loss to your own equipment whilst being used at College.

Note 2 – To qualify for a bursary, your total household income needs to either be less than £26,000 per year, or be in receipt of certain state benefits. Please see our bursary application form for more information and to apply.

- iPads ordered via this scheme will be delivered to your home address
- All iPads will be Space Grey. STM Dux cases will be supplied in either black or blue. We are **not** able to offer any choice of colour
- The iPad **must** be kept in the STM Dux case at all times for the insurance plan to be valid

Terms and Conditions for Portsmouth College subsidy payments

- 1) For students who subscribe to Option 1 (iPad Wi-Fi 32GB), Portsmouth College will make a contribution towards the monthly payment equivalent to £8 per month. The subsidy is available whether the device is purchased via monthly contributions or as a one off payment.
- 2) **Please note this subsidy is only available for Option 1.** If you subscribe to any other option, Portsmouth College is unable to offer any form of subsidy towards the cost.
- 3) To ensure delivery at the beginning of the academic year, Portsmouth College and Academia Ltd have reserved stock of the Option 1 device (iPad Wi-Fi 32GB) which is current as at 27th August 2020. In the event Apple make any changes to the product line subsequent to this date and replace this iPad with a different model, orders for Option 1 will continue to be fulfilled from the stock held.
- 4) The College contribution will be paid as a termly rebate according to the schedule below. In order to qualify for a rebate payment, you must remain a current student at Portsmouth College in the week when attendance checks are made.

- 5) Payments will be made via electronic BACS transfer to a nominated bank account in the United Kingdom. You will need to complete our **iPad Rebate Payments 2020/21 to 2021/22** form to provide details of your bank account and confirm your acceptance of these conditions. - 6) It is your responsibility to ensure that any changes to your bank account details are notified to the College Finance Office **before** the week in which attendance checks are made.
- 7) Portsmouth College is not authorised to provide independent financial advice. When you place an order for an iPad via a monthly payment scheme, you will be entering into a credit agreement with a finance provider via Academia Ltd. In the event you leave College and therefore no longer qualify for rebate payments from Portsmouth College, you will be liable for the full monthly payment due for the duration of the agreement.
